#### CALL TO ORDER AND FLAG SALUTE

## BOARD ADMINISTRATION

PUBLIC HEARING ON ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 93-1, SUMMIT STATION WATER IMPROVEMENTS Mr. Jones explained that the Notice of Hearing was mailed to all property owners within AD No. 93-1 on April 7, 1994. Assessment District #93-1 boundary map was filed with the Office of County Recorder on April 13, 1994.

Mr. Jim Garing, the Assessment District Engineer, described the proposed improvements to the boundaries of the Assessment District and explained the method and formula of assessment spread.

Mr. Jones reported that one protest had been received as of this date, May 18, 1994, representing 0.62% of the area.

Mr. Mac Brown explained the purpose of the Public Hearing. President Manriquez opened the floor for public comments.

Mike Seitz, District Deputy Counsel, said the language used in the easements was consistent with that which is used with San Luis Obispo County.

Mr. Richard Torgerson, Applegate APN 91-071-005 asked if District would have exclusive use of easement.

Answer: Any future use by another entity must be compatible with use of a water line.

Upon motion of Director Mendoza and seconded by Director Gracia, the Board approved and adopted Resolution 94-513 with Director Small as the dissenting vote.
