The Project Team has completed the following work items this month:

- Participation in Supplemental Water Committee meeting on September 8 Boyle
 presented alternative approaches to reduce high system pressures along the HWY
 101 corridor without installing individual pressure regulating valves on water services.
 These options will be presented at the Board Meeting on September 24, 2008, along
 with a Budget Revision Request to authorize Boyle to perform additional design work
 if desired by the District Board.
- Ground control and aerial photography of the project corridor Our surveyors placed aerial targets and performed ground control along the proposed project corridor.
- 3. Site visits to wells and proposed tank & pump station sites Boyle staff and District property acquisition consultant Lillian Jewell met with property owners to discuss locations for the proposed pipeline, pump station, and tank on the Mesa. The process of selecting locations and final alignments will take place over the next few months. To assist with this negotiation, Boyle and District staff are acquiring additional mapping within the vicinity of the preferred tank location.
- 4. Field meeting with California Department of Fish & Game (CDFG) to discuss approval for soil sampling in the Santa Maria riverbed Our subconsultants (Padre & Fugro) met with CDFG on September 9 to discuss vehicle access and disturbance required for borings. We are anticipating approval by CDFG for this work later this week (by September 12, 2008).
- Concept Design Report Boyle staff has been working on the bidding strategy, chloramination, and pipeline sections of the Concept Design Report. We are acquiring record drawings and schematics from several utility companies for use in our design.

Project Schedule

In our contract, we had assumed we would have approved right of entry agreements (ROEs) within 30 calendar days of Notice to Proceed. Due to additional time required for right of entry (ROE) agreements, and unanticipated delays in receiving CDFG approval, we need to revise the schedule for submitting the Geotechnical Report for HDD (Technical Memorandum #1 – originally scheduled for October 10) to November 7. We are assuming we will have approved ROEs and CDFG permit this Friday (September 12).

As shown on the attached schedule, this delay results in a two-week impact on the overall project schedule.
