The 2011 Interim rate increase request wasn't enacted until the 4th quarter of 2011. The disposal rates for hauling companies are going to remain unchanged until January 1, 2013. Inflation that was in the 3% range earlier in the year seems to be headed to 0% for the near term. And finally raising rates twice within a span of 6 months is neither practical nor politically doable.

Given all of the above, we will assume the 2012 interim rate request is zero. I will prepare a base year review in July 2012 for an expected effective date of 1-1-2013 if warranted.




