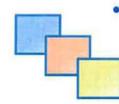

New Supplemental Water Op Fund

- Captures all revenue and obligations related to Supplemental Water
 - » Revenues from charges to Purveyors and District customers
 - » Supplemental Water cost from Santa Maria
 - » Annual Project replacement
 - » Portion of 2013 and 2013A COPs debt service
- Ensure all users pay their share of Supplemental Water Project
 - Purveyor's pay their Court mandated share



District customers pay their Court mandated share



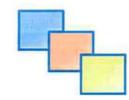

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Supplemental Water Charge Approach

- Assume Project Replacement amount is based on final Project Cost
 - Total Project cost with Phase 3 complete is \$33,651,640
 - Equals Bi-monthly Replacement recovery of \$37,342
 - Eliminates having different Replacement amount for each Project Phase
- Assume Normal Conditions
 - No Pumping Reductions

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Stabilize Recovery of Replacement and District Portion of Debt Service

 Same charge for replacement and debt service for each Project Phase and delivery amount

\$37,342 = Round((\$33,651,640/100 years/12 months),-3)*2*66.68%

\$7,881 = ((\$750,000-\$250,000)/12 months)-\$16,893 from Purveyors)*2

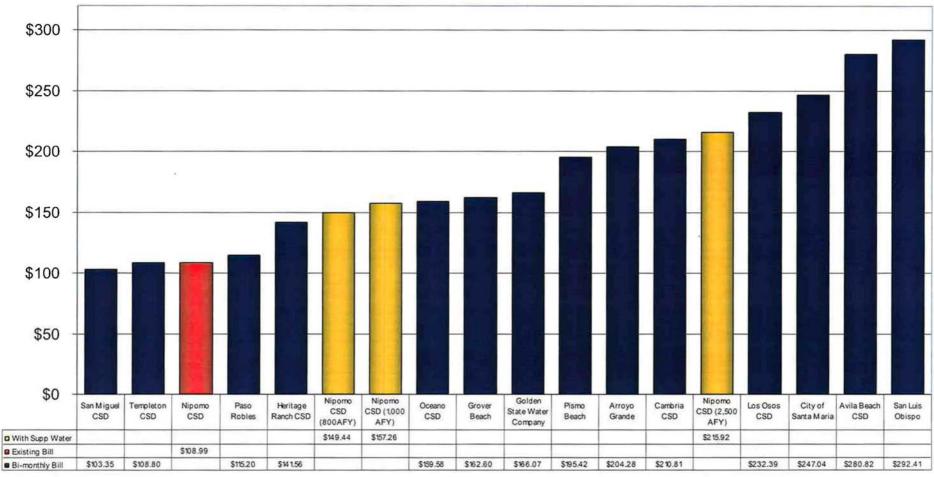

Water Rate Study

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Summary

- Fixed charges collect the revenue required to offset Supplemental Water costs
 - Only if District uses its planned amount of Supplemental Water and pumps the rest
 - Fixed charges assist in creating revenue stability for District, especially needed during Project start-up
- Variable charges introduces revenue uncertainty and very high water bills in upper tiers
 - <u>Key point</u>: If water sales are less than forecast, District will not collect the revenue necessary to pay Santa Maria
 - A 5% decrease in water sales volume with a 2,500 minimum take-or-pay results in a loss of \$145,000 annually
