
PROPERTY EXCHANGE FOR WATER DELIVERIES (APN 90-142-007)

In the past, Your Honorable Board has considered trading a parcel of land on Tefft Street next to District property in exchange for providing water service to the Nipomo Regional Park. This matter was discussed for a period of time and then dropped. At the last Regular Board Meeting held on January 17, 1996, the Board directed staff to revisit this idea of exchanging property for water. Staff contacted a County representative on this matter. The County would transfer the one-acre parcel (APN 90-142-007) located at the intersection of Tefft Street and Carillo Street to the District in exchange for water use at the Nipomo Regional Park. It is estimated that the property value of the parcel next to the District lot is approximately \$85,000. Presently the Park uses about \$22,000 worth of water annually.

The basic concept in this trade is that the District would deliver water in the value of \$85,000 in exchange for the County property located next to the District's property in which the proposed new office building is to be built.

The County would like an indication of the intent of the District to proceed in this matter. The attached Memorandum of Understanding is presented to Your Honorable Board for consideration.

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE NIPOMO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT AND THE COUNTY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO

WHEREAS, the Nipomo Community Services District ("District") is the water purveyor for the San Luis Obispo County Regional Park located in the District, and

WHEREAS, the County of San Luis Obispo ("County") owns a one-acre parcel of land, APN 90-142-007, ("Parcel") located at the intersection of Tefft Street and Carillo Street in the District, and

WHEREAS, the District is interested in developing District offices and related facilities on the Parcel, and

WHEREAS, the District is willing to provide water service to the Nipomo Regional Park in exchange for the Parcel, and

WHEREAS, the County is interested in receiving water services in exchange for the Parcel,

NOW, THEREFORE, WITH THE ABOVE IN MIND, THE UNDERSTANDING IS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the County will transfer the Parcel to the District in exchange for the District providing water service to the Nipomo Regional Park in an amount equal to the value of the Parcel.
- 2. That value of the Parcel is \$85,000.00.
- 3. That the District will provide water service to the Nipomo Regional Park at the District's regular water rates, in accordance with District policies and procedures, until the value of the water delivered to the Park equals \$85,000.00.
- 4. That the District will bi-monthly report the delivery of water to the Nipomo Regional Park to the County. When the value of water delivered equals \$85,000.00, then the County will commence paying for water services delivered to the Park in accordance with District's policies and procedures, as amended from time to time.
