Dear Mr. Morici:

Thank you for taking the time to meet with Chief Jenkins and myself concerning the Oceano Community Services District Fire Department's request for In-Lieu Off Highway Vehicle fees. As you are aware, the Oceano Dunes State Vehicular Recreation Area is a recreational destination for thousands of off road visitors each year. Fire Department emergency services are impacted by visitors all year round but more significantly during holiday periods. Emergency response call volume increases during these periods for all types of incidents due to the number of visitors traveling through and staying in the community.

We are requesting a portion of the In-Lieu Off Highway Vehicle fees to purchase needed equipment to continue our emergency services delivery to those visitors who may require our response. The purchase of equipment will also be of benefit to those users of the State Recreational Area within our jurisdiction. The purchases shall be identified dependent upon the needs of the department.

The list of equipment is identified in the following categories:

Rescue Equipment

- Rescue Ropes and Low Angle Rescue Equipment
- Vehicle Rescue Extrication Equipment

Medical Equipment \$21,754

- Medical/Vehicle Extrication Personal Protection Equipment

- Hose, Nozzles and Appliances
- Operational Supplies and Equipment
