REPORT FOR November 2009

During the month of November, the department responded to a total of 61 calls. 23 were in Oceano, 14 were in Grover Beach, 12 were in Arroyo Grande, 10 were with Cal Fire and 2 on the beach. Of the 23 calls in Oceano, 16 were EMS related, 2 fire and 5 miscellaneous calls. This puts the total as of this report at 733. This time last year the call total was 706.

Joint Training with Arroyo Grande and Grover Beach FD.

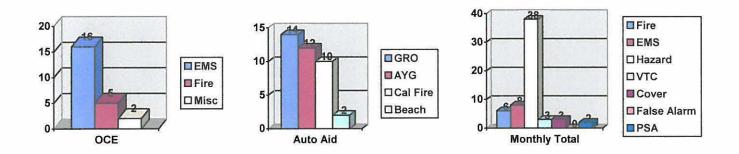
The departments trained together on residential and commercial structure fire ground operations.

Wallace Group recommends payment in the amount of \$68,217.48. The total current amount of the retention fund is now \$67,106.99.

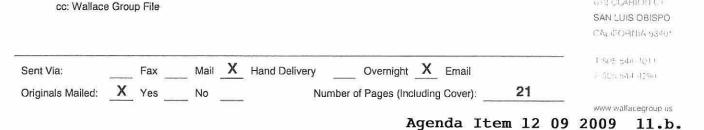

SUBJECT:	Approval and Adoption of the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Waterline Replacement Projects

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Staff recommends that the Board:

- Certify as complete and accurate the mitigated negative declaration for a project to replace existing waterlines located on 14th Street, within the Beach Street Alley, on Pier Avenue, within the Pacific Avenue Alley, on Norswing Drive and on Pershing Drive in the community of Oceano.
- 2. Adopt the attached Resolution 2009-16, with findings that the proposed waterline replacements are necessary and the projects have been reviewed in compliance with requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- 3. Direct Staff to obtain permits as necessary from the California Coastal Commission and County of San Luis Obispo Planning and Building Department.
- 4. Direct General Manager to sign and file the Notice of Determination to the Office of Planning and Research and the San Luis Obispo County Clerk.
- 5. Direct Staff to file the Environmental Document and pay the Environmental Document Filing Fee (\$1993.00) to the County Clerk Recorder for the California Department of Fish and Game per section 711.4 of the California Fish and Game Code.

FUNDING:

The Board authorized Staff to pursue funding through the Economic Recovery Bill signed into law in February, 2009, California's Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SDWSRF). The California's Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund was to receive approximately \$160 million in funds (in addition to their regular annual budget). These funds were to be distributed to "shovel-ready" projects as a priority. Staff completed and submitted a pre-application for all five waterline projects in the amount of \$1,200,000. The District was not selected as part of the SDWSRF but directed Staff to continue with the environmental review and permit processing for all of the waterline segments. Should other funding become available in the future, these projects

will now have already completed the required environmental review and can be ready for construction much more quickly.

DISCUSSION:

This is a recommendation for the Board of Directors to approve the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the replacement of five (5) existing waterlines located on 14th Street; within the Beach Street Alley; on Pier Avenue; within the Pacific Avenue Alley; and on Norswing Drive/Pershing Drive in the community of Oceano. The purpose of these waterline replacements is to repair and/or replace various water supply pipelines throughout the Oceano Community Services District in order to serve both existing and future customers within the District's service area. In so doing, these improvements will improve the water quality within the OCSD in order to achieve AWWA standards for drinking water and provide the required flow of water for fire protection. By replacing existing broken or cracked water pipelines that may be in proximity to undetected sewer line breaks, the risks for cross-contamination and potentially significant health risks are decreased. The proposed project/action involves:

- Segment 1 Replacement of 450 linear feet of existing two inch steel pipe with an eight inch PVC pipe and approximately 300 linear feet of waterline laterals on 14th Street from Rice Street to Wilmar Avenue with an estimated site disturbance of 7,500 square feet;
- <u>Segment 2</u> Replacement of 860 linear feet of existing two and four inch steel pipes with a twelve inch PVC pipe and approximately 200 linear feet of waterline laterals within the Beach Street Alley from 17th Street to 21st Street with an estimated site disturbance of 10,600 square feet;
- <u>Segment 3</u> Replacement of 665 linear feet of existing six inch asbestos cement pipe with a ten inch PVC pipe and approximately 75 linear feet of waterline laterals on Pier Avenue from the Pier Avenue Bridge to the Pacific Avenue Alley with an estimated site disturbance of 7,400 square feet;
- <u>Segment 4</u> Replacement of approximately 760 linear feet of existing four inch asbestos cement pipe with a ten inch PVC pipe and approximately 110 linear feet of waterline laterals within the Pacific Avenue Alley from Truman Drive to Mendel Drive with an estimated site disturbance of 8,700 square feet and
- <u>Segment 5</u> Replacement of 900 linear feet of existing one and two inch steel pipes with an eight inch PVC pipe and approximately 140 linear feet of waterline laterals on Norswing Drive from Pershing Drive to Pier Avenue and on Pershing Drive from Norswing Drive to the Pacific Avenue Alley with an estimated site disturbance of 10,400 square feet.

The existing pipelines consist of one, two and four inch steel pipes as well as four and six inch asbestos cement pipes. Many of these existing pipelines are incapable of handling increased water pressures and flows necessary to provide adequate fire protection. Replacement water pipelines are increased in size as compared to existing pipelines in order to ensure sufficient fire flows. None of these upsized pipelines are intended to serve new development beyond individual vacant parcels located in the immediate project area.

All construction work associated with the proposed waterline replacements will involve some open trench removal and replacement. The maximum width of the excavation trench will be ten feet in order to allow for vehicle access and avoidance of other existing pipelines. The feasibility of pipe bursting is also being investigated, as it relates to asbestos cement pipe, increases in size, and depth of soil cover over the pipe. Since several of the existing pipelines to be removed involve asbestos cement pipe, these removal activities will conform to Air Pollution Control District and Cal OSHA requirements for removal of potentially hazardous materials.

All work will be within public right-of-way and construction will disturb 44,600 SF (1.02 Acres).

A Phase 1 archaeological study was prepared. Mitigation measures including archaeological monitoring during construction will mitigate any potential impacts to an insignificant level.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

Comments were received from Air Pollution Control District (APCD) and County of San Luis Obispo Public Works during the State Clearinghouse public comment period. APCD evaluated the construction impacts of the proposed project by comparing it against screening models within APCD's Air Quality Handbook. This evaluation indicated that construction phase impacts will likely be less than the APCD's significance threshold values of 185 lbs of emissions per day and 2.5 tons of emissions per quarter.

Although the proposed project does not exceed APCD thresholds for generation of fugitive dust and other construction-related emissions, the APCD requires implementation of a variety of dust control measures including watering of graded surfaces and dirt stockpiles, planting and/or stabilization of disturbed soil areas, covering of hauling trucks, street sweeping at the end of each construction day as well as the potential for encountering hydrocarbon contaminated soils and naturally occurring asbestos. Mitigation measure Air Quality 14 and 15 were added to address encountering hydrocarbon contaminated soils and naturally occurring asbestos.

In addition, proper maintenance of construction equipment, the use of approved diesel fuel and the replacement of diesel equipment will reduce emissions from construction equipment (see Mitigation Measures Air Quality 1-18).

San Luis Obispo County Public Works did not have any comments.

Segments 3, 4 and 5 are located within the County's coastal zone boundary. County Coastal Land Use Ordinance Section 23.08.286. b.(1) requires a plot plan approval for all projects disturbing less than 40,000 SF of material. Segments 3, 4 and 5 disturb 26,500 SF. The California Coastal Commission has direct jurisdiction over segments 3 and 5, however, the Commission may extend their review to also include segment 4. A Coastal Development Permit will therefore need to be processed through the California Coastal Commission.

Segments 1 and 2 are located in San Luis Obispo County Inland area. They qualify for a zoning clearance according to Title 22 Section 22.30.360 B.1 which applies to all sites with disturbance less than 40,000 SF. Segments 1 and 2 disturb 18,100 SF.

Because the Oceano Lagoon is within the jurisdiction of the California Department of Fish and Game, and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, permits from these agencies must be secured prior to beginning work in that area. A biological assessment was reviewed which identified a variety of habitat types that might be indirectly impacted. California Red-Legged Frog was detected near one segment of the project area adjacent to Oceano Lagoon, and may be present during the construction period. Mitigation measures have been incorporated into the project to reduce the potential impacts to California Red-Legged frogs and other sensitive wildlife species to an insignificant level. Measures are proposed such as biological construction monitoring, temporary fencing of sensitive habitat, a worker training program, and limiting the work area to the minimum practicable extent. The construction of Segments 3 and 5 may indirectly impact the downstream willow riparian scrub, seasonal emergent wetlands, coastal freshwater marsh and open water habitats adjacent to and within the Oceano Lagoon and mitigation measures have been prepared to address any impacts (see Biological Resources 19-35).

PROJECT/ACTION TIMING

Project construction is anticipated to occur within two to three months of project approval by the Oceano Community Services District and the securing of approvals from any other involved local, State, or Federal agencies.

Project construction will require approximately four months to complete all required excavation, pipeline removal and replacement and restoration of the pipeline routes to their previous conditions.

RESULTS:

Adoption of this Mitigated Negative Declaration with required posting will complete the environmental review phase of this project. The project will provide replacement waterlines in the project area. Through design and mitigation, adverse environmental impacts will be minimized to the maximum extent possible.

SUBJECT: CAPACITY OF OCSD DELIVERY SYSTEM FOR IMPORTED WATER

Due to a sudden increase in chemicals, in a sentry well near the beach, (that indicated possible saltwater intrusion) it was generally agreed that the Oceano Community Services District (OCSD) groundwater pumping operations should be reduced as much and as quickly as possible. At the time this issue came to our attention (September 2009), it appeared that the Lopez distribution system would be unable to deliver 100% of our purchased water. The first step in solving that problem was to determine the capacity of the OCSD imported water metering station on Brisco Road.

Upon investigation of the meter station, it was determined that if the Cla-valve (globe-style control valve), and its associated orifice plate were to be removed, the flow of imported water to OCSD could quite possibly be increased. Before the job was attempted, it was noted that the Cla-valve in the meter station was in the wide open position. The flow was timed at 515 gal/min (830 acft/yr). The globe-style valve and the orifice plate were removed. The flow was then timed again and it had increased to 585 gal/min (941 acft/yr). This was a 13.5% increase in flow.

OCSD has contracted for 750 acft/yr (464 gal/min) of State project water and 303 acft/yr (188 gal/min) of Lopez water. This adds up to a total of 1053 acft/yr (652 gal/min) of imported water. However, 41 acft/yr (25.7 gal/min) of Lopez water is presently being delivered through the Arroyo Grande metering station and wheeled by the City of Arroyo Grande to (OCSD) water customers both inside (2 Halcyon Mobile Home Parks) and outside (Canyon Crest & Christie Family) the District. After deducting the 41 acft/yr of wheeled water we would only need to push 1012 acft/yr (626 gal/min) of imported water through the Lopez metering station. This would still left us short, by approximately 71 (acft/yr), of being able to get our full combined entitlement from the Lopez and the State Water projects.

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In the past, (OCSD) has experienced occasional excesses above the Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) of nitrates. In addition, we continue to experience occasional excesses of selenium above the MCL, in two of the Oceano production wells. Because of these water quality issues, the State Department of Environmental Health Services has required that we create and use an acceptable blending program. Our blending program requires that the water used for blending (State and Lopez water), be delivered to the water tanks (central location), before it can be pumped into the water system. This is to insure that the blended water we supply will be of equal quality in all sections of the District's water system.

However, we do have a by-pass system in place at Lancaster Drive. The by-pass allows us to put the imported water directly into the northeast corner of the District's water distribution system. This system was installed to be used in the event of an emergency such as a main break, natural disaster, etc.

If we did not operate the District's two water production wells that are high in selenium, we would not be restricted by the State Health Department's blending requirements and we could place the Lancaster Drive by-pass system in operation. Due to a resulting decrease in friction losses when the by-pass is in use, we are able to get an additional 15% of water from the Lopez and State water distribution system. With the Lancaster Drive by-pass system in operation, (valve open) we can receive 675 gal/min (1087 acft/yr). <u>This means that theoretically the Lopez distribution system would then be able to deliver all of our Lopez and State Project water entitlement.</u>

The following paragraphs are just for your general information:

During the summer months, Oceano often uses an average flow of as much as 672 gal/min (89 acft/month). This indicates that in the summer months, we will still need to operate some of the District wells in order to meet peak day demands.

Conversely during the winter months, Oceano often uses an average flow of as little as 431 gal/min (53 acft/month). This indicates that during the winter months, we will have to reduce the flows from Lopez to keep the tanks from over flowing.
