3. COMMUNICATION AND CONTENT

The April 2, 2008, letter discusses some concerns that Gerald Trimble has with the Proposed Decision filed on March 3, 2008. Those concerns in the April 2 letter are summarized as follows:

- Only a single issue was referenced in the Proposed Decision.
- Many far more crucial issues were presented during the proceeding.
- Rate surcharges are discriminatory in violation of the California Constitution.
- Court granted prescriptive groundwater right is to be forfeited by the Stipulation.
- GSWC Stipulation claim of allocation of groundwater to GSWC has no merit.
- PD's dismissal "without prejudice" allows a repeat of same problem.
- GSWC confirms a subsequent application will include only added testimony.
- Three prerequisites are recommended to be included in the PD
 - 1. GSWC Stipulation must not be discriminatory in any rate surcharge.
 - 2. GSWC Stipulation must allow the court granted prescriptive right to stand.
 - 3. GSWC Stipulation legal flaws of allocation omission must be corrected.
