

## **Sewer plant letter wrong**

The recent letter to the editor, entitled "Speaking out on sewer plant," contains false statements that must be corrected.

The Nipomo Community Services District (NCSD) is not proposing a sewer plant at 776 Mesa Road, as alleged by the letter writer. The board has approved the concept of expanding the existing Southland wastewater treatment facility adjacent to Highway 101.

The Draft Water and Sewer Master Plan considered by the NCSD board at its Nov. 28 meeting does not propose additional disposal works as alleged by that letter writer. In fact, the draft plan is clear that NCSD is still studying options to accommodate additional disposal of treated wastewater, and no decision has been made at this time.

Readers can download the Draft Water and Sewer Master Plan from NCSD's Web site ([www.ncsd.ca.gov](http://www.ncsd.ca.gov)) and read the report for themselves.

That letter writer has done a disservice to Nipomo by writing erroneous information.
