Dear Mr. Snyder:

Please accept this letter in response to your letter of November 3, 2010, received by the Nipomo Community Services District ("District") on November 4, 2010, which the District interprets as a request for public records. This response has been reviewed by District Legal Counsel, Jon S. Seitz, and is the person responsible for raising objections referenced in this response.

Cal. Gov. Code §6253(b) requires a public records request to "reasonably describe an identifiable record or records". The District is not required to investigate or confirm statements alleged to have been made by a District official at meetings. Therefore, the request for regulations, law, code or rules supporting the alleged comments of a director at an SAIC meeting does not reasonably describe an identifiable record or records. See additionally the case of *Rogers v. Superior Court* (1993) 19 Cal App. 4<sup>th</sup> 469, 23 Cal. Rptr. 2<sup>nd</sup> 412, holding that individuals should not be permitted to make a general unfocused request for public records to a public agency.

Therefore, the District will not investigate or produce documents in response to your request.
