Water purveyors set supply info meeting

Nipomo Mesa water purveyors will hold a meeting Tuesday to provide the public with information about the groundwater supply.

The meeting is set for 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. in Olympic Hall at Nipomo High School, 525 N. Thompson Road.

Nipomo Community Services District, Golden State Water Co., Rural Water Co. and Woodlands Mutual Water Co. are presenting the meeting, titled "A Candid Community Conversation: Water on the Mesa."

Topics will include a history of the Mesa's water supply issues as well as why purveyors believe the groundwater supply is threatened by seawater intrusion.

Options that were considered for ensuring an adequate supply and what those options mean for property owners also will be discussed.
