The San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors voted 4-1 to cast \$90,000 of benefit units by the county Flood Control District in favor of the Nipomo Supplemental Water Project.

Fourth District Supervisor Paul Teixeira voted against the project and made the motion that SLO County cast a neutral vote but failed to get a second. He felt residents of the South County should decide this issue, not the San Luis Obispo County Board of Supervisors.
